INSTALLING RESPONDUS LOCKDOWN BROWSER

If Respondus LockDown Browser has already been installed, you can skip this section. To download Respondus LockDown Browser, follow these steps:

Windows:

- Your institution will provide the link for downloading and installing Respondus LockDown Browser.
- During the installation, select **Yes** if prompted to accept the license agreement.
- Follow the onscreen instructions to complete the install.

Mac:

- Be sure that OSX 10.5 or higher is being used (512K RAM minimum).
- Your institution will provide the link for downloading and installing Respondus LockDown Browser.
- Follow the download page instructions to obtain the correct file.
- Start the LockDown Browser installation program and follow the onscreen instructions to complete the installation.

TAKING A TEST

- Close all programs, unless one is used to connect you to the internet.
- Locate the "LockDown Browser" shortcut on the desktop and double-click it. (For Mac users, launch "LockDown Browser" from the Applications folder.)
- If prompted, either close a blocked program (e.g. screen capture, image, or video) by clicking **Yes**. Or, close Respondus LockDown Browser and click **Yes** before clicking **Yes**.
- Log in to the Respondus LockDown Browser.
- Navigate to the test and select it.
- If the Respondus LockDown Browser is already installed, click **Begin Exam**.
- The test will then start. (Note, once a test has been
