Introduction to the Transfer Housing Selection Guide

Logging Into Your RESIDENCE Account

If you are a transfer student at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, you must know a few things before logging into RESIDENCE for the first time. To access your new Housing RESIDENCE online account, you need to contact the Office of Residential Life at 870-575-7256 or email reslife@uapb.edu to receive the temporary password for your account. **Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM; located at the Delta Annex Suite 111.**

Please note newly admitted students will have to wait a minimum of 48 hours before they can complete the housing application.
