- School of Education admission requirements include a minimum 2.75 GPA, and passage of the Core Academic Skills for Educators: minimum scores: Reading (5712) 156, Writing (5722) 162, Math (5732) 150). A student may not take the Praxis Core Exams more than once in a 21-day period. If taken twice, the second scores will not be reported and the test fee will not be refunded.
- Students who have not passed the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators Examinations by the end of the Freshman year must take Testing Seminar and pay a one - time \$15 Learning Plus Lab fee.
- Act 1313 of 1997 requires a state and national background check. If you have been convicted of a felony, you may not be eligible to obtain an Arkansas Teaching License.
- Additionally, you must complete the following workshops: Child Maltreatment, Youth Suicide Prevention Awareness, Arkansas History, and Parent Education. Check with your Education advisor regularly; these state requirements may change at any time.
- Students must pass all parts of the Praxis II examinations before student teaching. Minimum scores: (#10041 Content Knowledge): 159, (#20042 Essays): 150, and (#30043 Pedagogy): 145.
